

## Pop Art Self Portraits

Materials:

12"x18" white paper

pencils

Sharpie markers

watercolor paints

Students view artwork by the artist Roy Lichtenstein. Discuss how words can be used in conjunction with an image. Review Lichtenstein's use of the primary colors. Before creating their self portraits, students write their name at the top of a piece of paper which are then passed around each table and each student writes one positive words about each other student as the papers are passed. By the end the students have a paper with at least 12 positive words that their classmates had written about them. The students then choose their favorite word and use that when creating their Pop Art self portrait.
