

## Drawing Birds

### Materials:

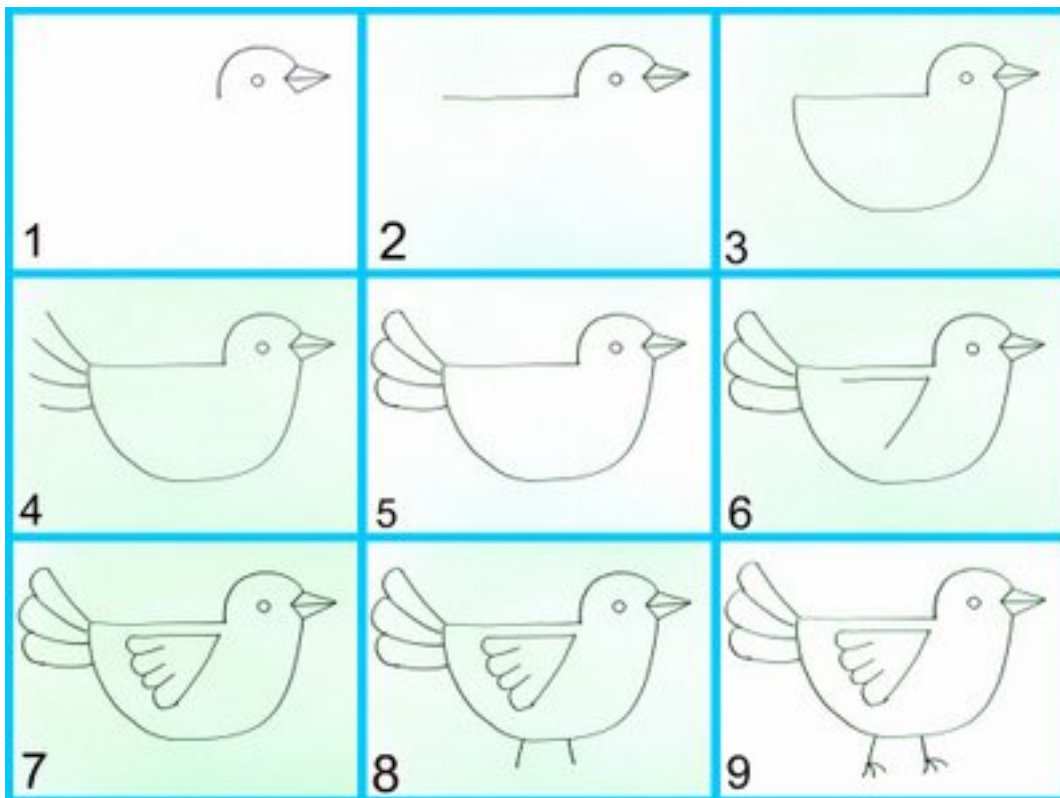
- Light color oil pastel s(if using black paper or a dark color oil pastel if using a light paper),
- Tempera paint mixed with a bit of white to create pastel tones
- Feathers.



Everyone has their own method for drawing birds. The shape easy and recognizable enough for all kids to master. Start with a circle for the eye.

Tip: To ensure proper placement of the eye, explain where the eye should go, then have each child point to that place on their paper. This is an important step as most children will put the eye anywhere on the page, resulting in frustration with the later steps.

On the right side of the page, directly in front of the eye, draw an arrow pointing to the eye. This is the beginning of the beak. From here, the illustrations should be enough to get you going.
