- Vote to approve a request for a Bridges Math consultant to serve as a mentor to our staff at our March Professional Development Day. The cost for the Bridges consultant to come to our school to lead a 3-hour session is \$1500. This workshop will benefit all 27 classroom teachers. The funds would come from the PFC's unallocated strategic funds.
 - M'Lissa motioned for a vote for PFC to pay \$1500 for Bridges mentor at March Professional Development Day
 - Shakeya seconded the motion
 - Lang gave an overview of the program and what the \$1500 will provide for teachers
 - Question: How much did we originally pay for original Bridges training?
 - **Answer**: \$5100
 - Question: What is going to happen moving forward regarding Bridges training?
 - Answer: There is a hope that PFC allocates funds for professional development. How those funds are spent may vary. Many different models for professional development.
 - Question: Will there be additional requests for Bridges funding on top of allocated funds from PFC for professional development?
 - **Answer:** The hope is that there will not be a request, but it is possible.
